Station Worship – July 11, July 18, July 25, August 1

We will explore the use of stations in the Celebration Center as part of this worship experience, including a labyrinth and prayer stations with various objects.

Our theme will be the journeys of the prophets Amos and Hosea.

Quilts and Comfort Worship – August 8, August 15, August 22, August 29

Gathering on quilts and comfortable chairs, our August worship will center around Families of Faith.
